### Things to Know:

Many spaces outside of The Grove will be shared with other guest groups. This includes the east and west fields, tennis courts, mini golf, pool, and basketball courts. Please check with Sarah on availability.

### Snack Shack

Any time the pool and mini golf is open, the Snack Shack will also be open with items to purchase including drinks, ice cream and snacks!

### Open Swim/Mini-Golf:

Times marked as OPEN swim and mini-golf mean the facilities are open to all groups on Camp. There will be capacity limits, but staff will work to rotate people in and out so everyone can enjoy!

### Recreation Sign-Ups

The Climbing Tower, Giant Swing/Zipline and Outdoor School classes require sign-ups. Sign-up sheets will be available at the Pool Party on Wednesday, after that they will be located inside the Grove Commons. Be sure to pay attention to age/attire requirements.

### Sports Equipment

Sporting equipment (balls, paddles, etc.) are available for check out at the Guest Service window in Cedar Lodge. Equipment must be returned to the same location. Board games & puzzles (no check out necessary) are also available in Cedar Lodge.

### Kids 2 Camp Benefit Day (Saturday, July 26 at Noon):

You are invited to a day of fun! Join in on carnival games and a nostalgic Camp lunch at Noon. Lunch will be followed by a presentation where you'll learn more about the Kids 2 Camp program and the difference it makes at Warm Beach Camp. There is NO CHARGE for activities or lunch, but there will be a few items available for purchase, as well as an opportunity to support the Kids 2 Camp program.

### Notes..

To make your stay at Warm Beach Camp more enjoyable and safe:

1. The speed limit on the grounds is 5 MPH. This is for safety reasons and dust control. Thank you for your cooperation!
2. Cooking is not permitted in rooms or cabins.
3. Alcohol and marijuana are not permitted on the grounds. Smoking permitted outside only, per Washington State law.
4. Quiet hours are 11:00pm-7:00am
5. No ground contact fires in the RV area. Fires in approved metal containers only.
6. Bikes: Please use extreme caution when riding on the trails. Horse riding lesson participants also use trails, and bikes can scare the horses.
